

# Ember Privacy Policy

October 11th, 2022

This policy is based on the requirements set out by the Swedish Data Protection Authority, in order to comply with the GDPR regulation, put in action from May 25 2018<sup>1</sup>.

When you contact Ember, you provide us with personal information. By contacting us, you approve that we store and use the information for our internal purposes. We do not distribute your information to third party without your consent, unless we are required to do so to meet legal requirements.

If you choose to contact us through e-mail or form, we always store your e-mail address, your name and, if provided, your company name. We also store any additional information that you share with us to be able to follow up a contact in the future, i.e. based on legitimate interests.

We store your information as long as we feel necessary, to be able to follow up on a contact or track the progress of your company.

We will inform you if we suspect that your personal information has leaked from us. Your information will be stored in cloud services outside the borders of Sweden, mainly through cloud services supplied by Google and Capsule (Zestia Ltd). Information needed for accounting and for agreements is stored within the borders of Sweden.

If we fail to deliver on this policy, and do not correct the issue upon request, we recommend that you contact The Swedish Data Protection Authority for further assistance.
